Membership High Point Rules

2015

1. In order to be eligible for GCSC championship awards, you must be a paid member of GCSC prior to the first show of the season and be in good standing with the club in accordance with the GCSC By-Laws.
2. Only points earned from the GCSC will be counted toward high point awards in each division. Points earned at other shows do not count toward these awards.
3. In order to be eligible for High Point awards, the member must meet the work requirement of 20 hours as stated in the By-Laws.
4. Attend a minimum of two GCSC meetings.
5. Show in 70% of GCSC regular shows.
6. The rider and horse that has the most points by division at the end of the season will be the winner of the High Point Championship. (One horse-one rider). Awards are given in the following divisions:
 - a. English
 - b. Speed/Agility
 - c. Racking
 - d. Western
 - e. Halter
7. High Point Championship results will be posted periodically through the show season.
8. Winners and awards are presented at the Christmas Dinner in December.
